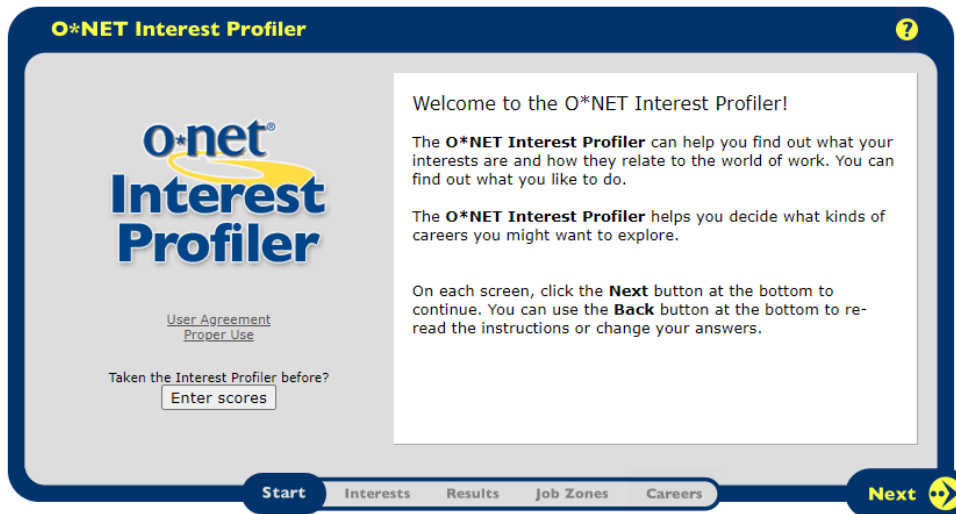
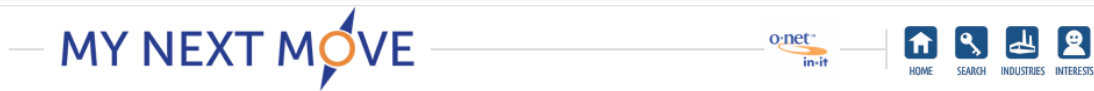


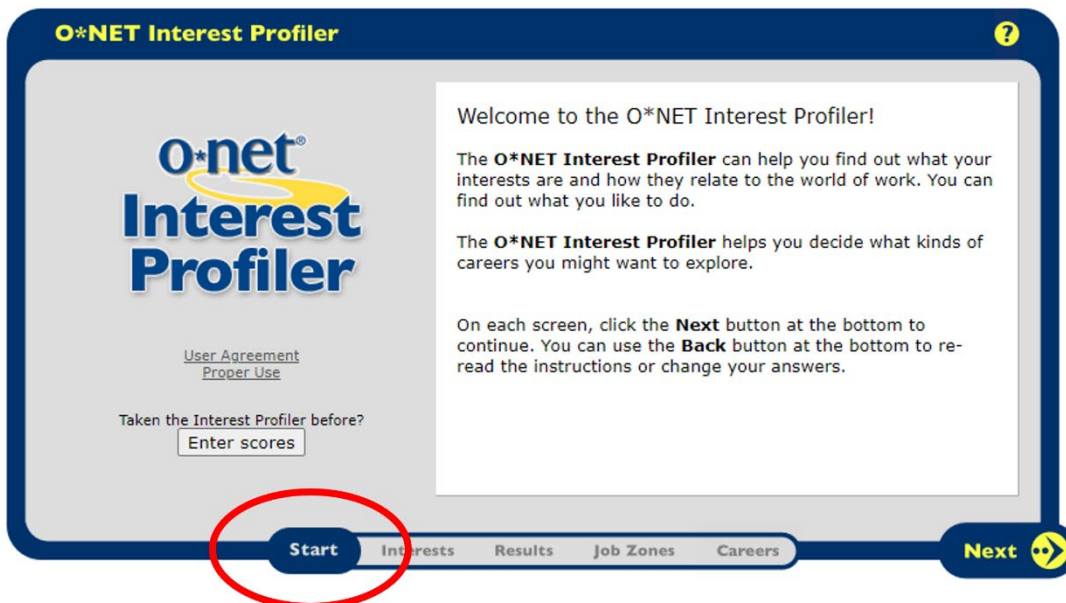
# 1: How to Navigate Inside the Assessment.



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To navigate between screens, use the next and back buttons. If a student wishes to see a previous screen have them press the back button but do not refresh the page or progress may be lost.
